Highlight of New Changes for 2023

- All courts (pickleball, tennis, basketball, volleyball, horseshoe) are now available to reserve for a fee.
 - Courts still operate on a first come, first serve basis if there is no reservation.
 - Hourly reservations are available to reserved online.
 - o Tournaments must be scheduled through Parks & Recreation.
 - There are no time limits on courts.
- All Local Non-profit Youth Leagues may still reserve fields at no cost. All other groups must pay a reservation fee – this is for any type of field use, including practices and games.
- All reservation fees must be paid no later than 24 hours of making the reservation.
- ♣ For youth field reservations, one representative from each youth league will be responsible for reserving field time, not individual coaches. Any changes to the reservations will need to go through your league representative.
- Automated lights are coming to Reinhart Volunteer Park Softball Hub Fields 1-4!

Recdesk Sign-up Instructions

Recdesk is the scheduling website Parks & Recreation uses to manage all reservations within city parks. Our website allows you to track your reservation, pay for your reservation (if applicable) and utilize our calendar to check for availability.

Users who want to make a reservation **MUST** create an account to get their field scheduled. Once your account is created, then you will be able to call or email me with your reservation requests.

To create your account, go to the link below, then click the "Create Account" button and follow instructions.

Once your reservation has been entered into recdesk, you will receive an automated email that contains your reservation date and time block.

Please keep this email, as it serves as your receipt and confirms your reservation.



General Scheduling Information

- All scheduled use of fields is through the Parks & Recreation Department.
- Users may request use of specific fields, but no guarantees can be made at the time of submission, as decisions will be based on maximizing the use of facilities.
- All users MUST create an account through our recdesk software to make a reservation.
- Confirmation of reservations will be provided via email and available through your recdesk profile.
 - Keep this email confirmation available on your phone or print a copy to have on hand on when you are on the field in the event there is a dispute/conflict about a reservation.
- Providing proof of insurance is mandatory and must be received by Parks & Recreation before use of a field. Please provide your Certificate of Liability/Insurance Binder as soon as possible.
 - Your insurance coverage must be in the amount of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate, naming the City of Grants Pass as an additional insured.
- ♣ For users who must pay a fee to reserve our facilities, all fees must be paid within 24 hours of making the reservation. Failure to do so will result in your reservation being cancelled.

Cancellations:

- The demand for our fields is high. If you have a reservation and decide not to use it, please contact Parks & Recreation so it can be made available to other users.
- If you have paid for a reservation, you must contact us 48 hours in advance to receive a refund of the fee.

Youth League Scheduling

Field Scheduling

- Fields will open for practice beginning **Monday, March 13** (pending any inclement weather)
- ♣ One representative from each youth league will be responsible for reserving field time, not individual coaches.
- ♣ Field time blocks will be assigned for each league, but it is the league's responsibility to assign team schedules within those time blocks.
- All youth league representatives will need to email requested fields and times to <u>recreation@grantspassoregong.gov</u> by <u>February 24</u>.
 - Initial time blocks will be assigned for Babe Ruth (formerly Little League) baseball and softball, as well as USA Lady Rogues.
 - All other youth leagues, please submit your first and second choices of desired fields and times.
 - o Unless assigned otherwise, time blocks will be 1.5 hours each.
 - The time blocks will be back-to-back, so all warm-up and cleanup times must be done within the assigned time block. Please do not run over into the next leagues time block.
 - Field practice reservations will be confirmed by the week of March 6.

Batting Cages

- The Hub and Agnew Lytle batting cages will be available for reservation via our online recdesk reservation website.
 - Individual youth coaches can make their own reservations.
 - o Each coach is allowed one (1) hour reservation per week.
 - If we see that there is not a lot of usage by multiple users, and there is a demand from coaches for more time during the week, we can adjust this allowance.
 - A code will be required to access the keys for the batting cages, so if you do not receive the code via email, make sure to contact us for the code prior to your reservation.
 - See attached map for location of each batting cage.
 - Agnew Lytle Batting Cages are prohibited to use if a game is schedule on the field.

Adult League Scheduling

Field Scheduling

- Games can be scheduled in advance but will not begin until Babe Ruth Season ends. (We do not have an end date currently)
- Practices can be scheduled now by individual coaches in 1.5-hour time blocks if there is availability after youth league field reservations are confirmed.

Keys

Keys for certain field lights and other facilities may be checked out to users. A \$25 deposit is required. Keys must be returned to the Parks & Recreation Department within 30 days of the season's end otherwise the deposit is forfeit.


